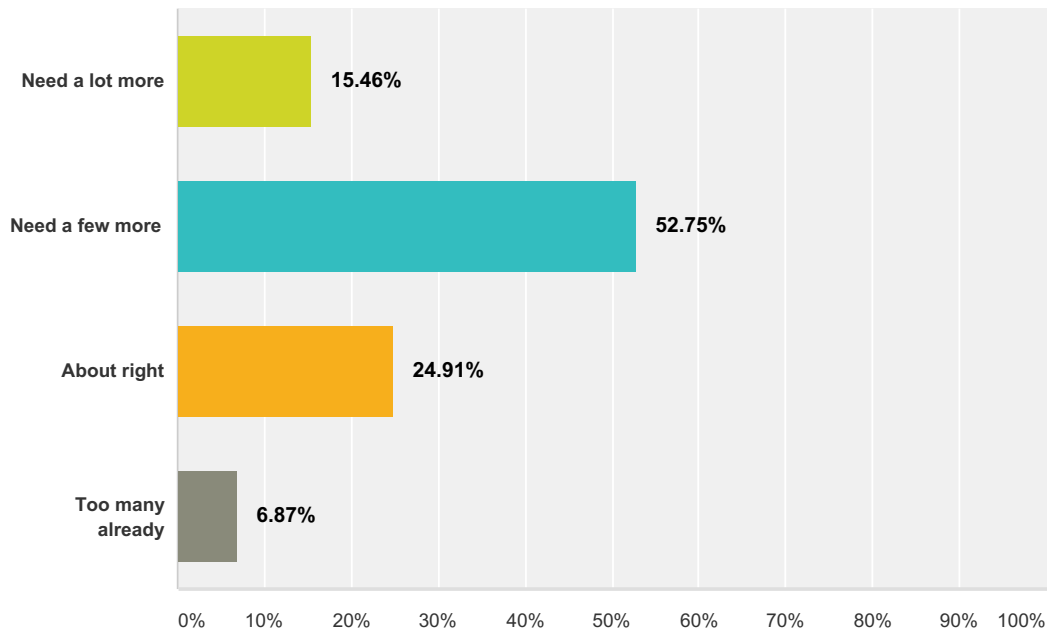

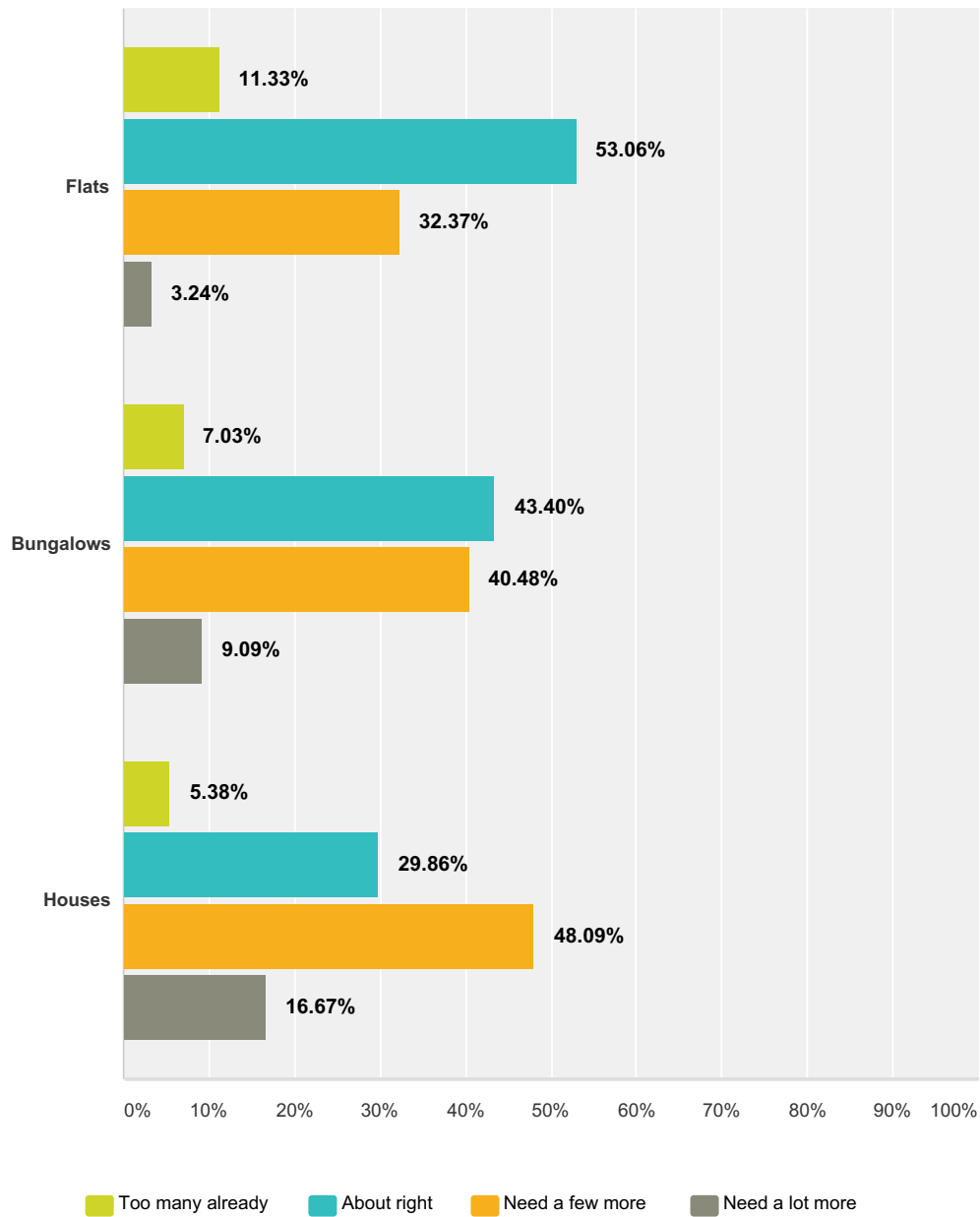

## Q2 What do you think about the current composition of housing in Lavenham:

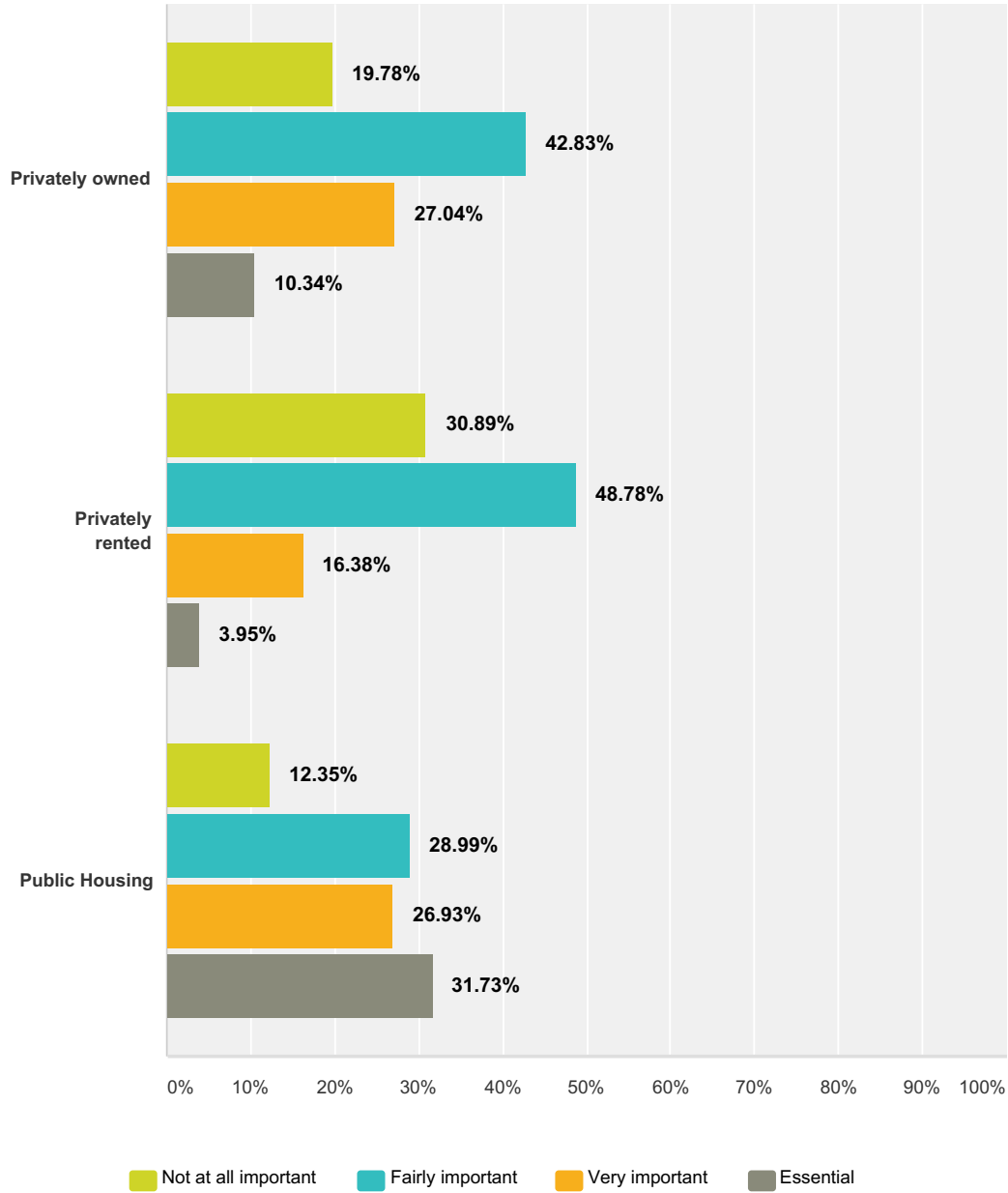

### Q6 In your opinion how many new homes should be built in the village in the next 20 years?(Please tick)

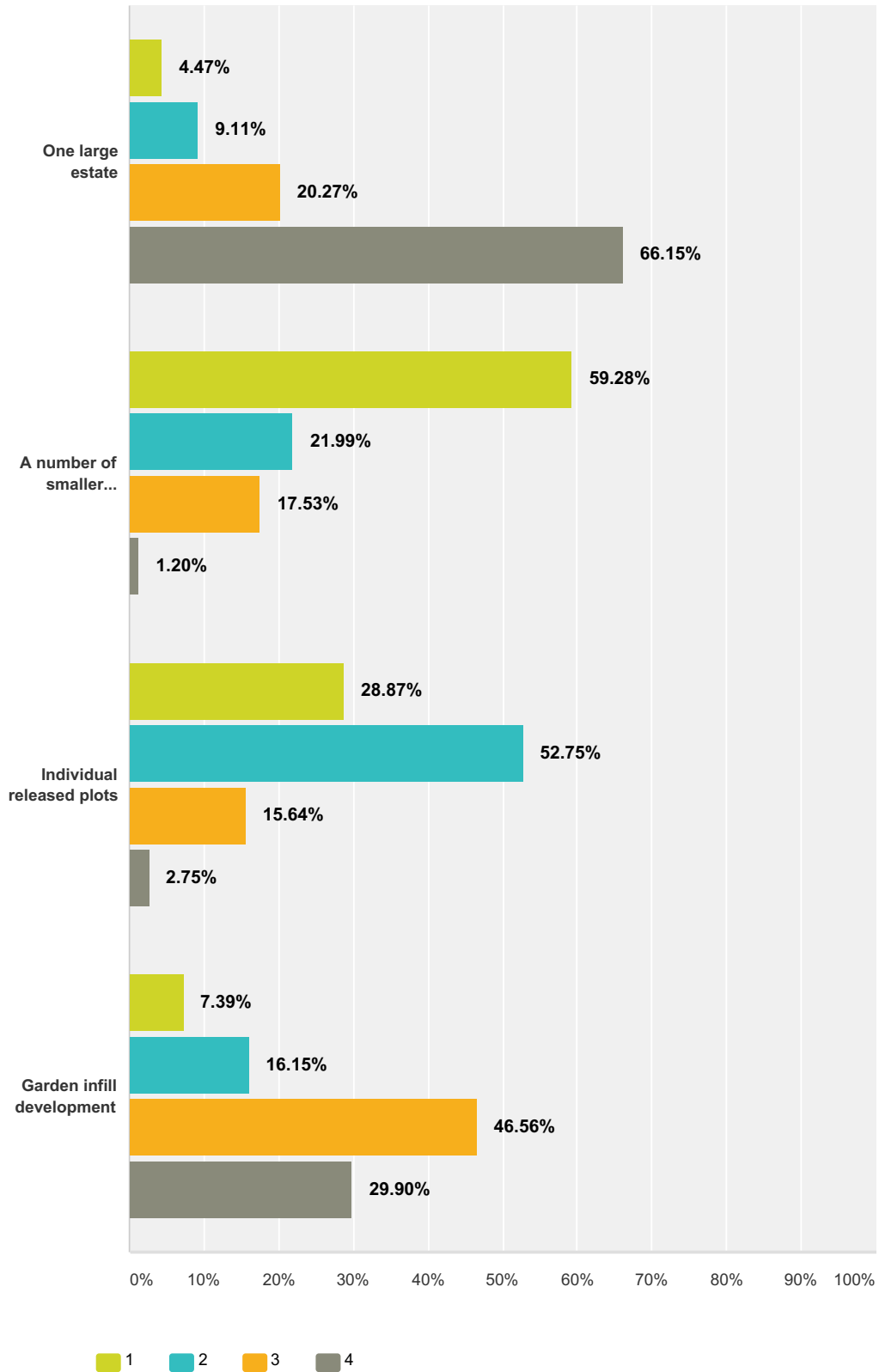

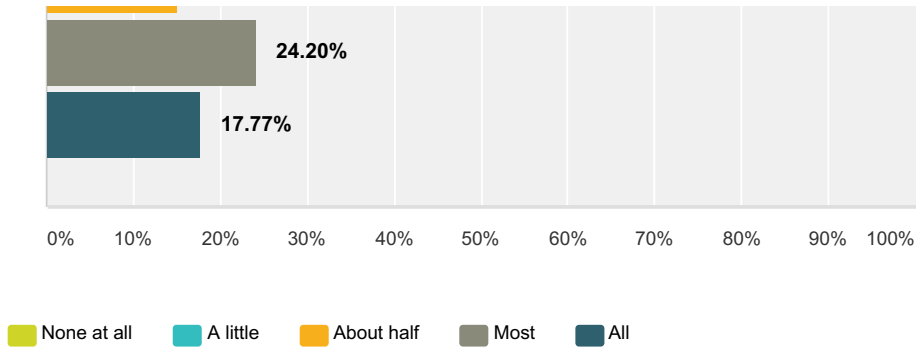


**Q14 Listed below are various things that most of us spend money on. Please tick what proportion of your household spend for each of the following categories is spent within the village**

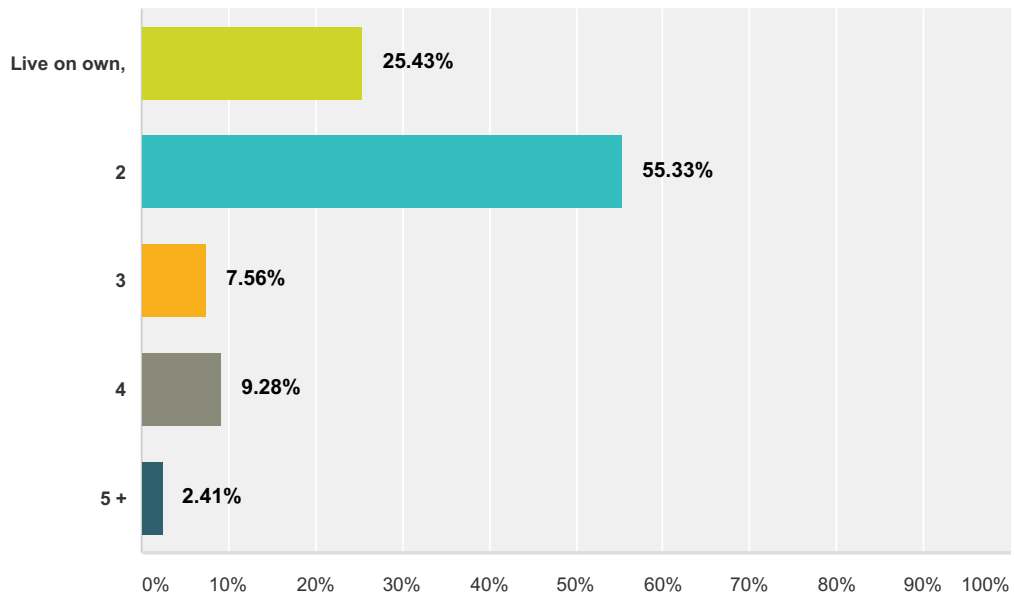

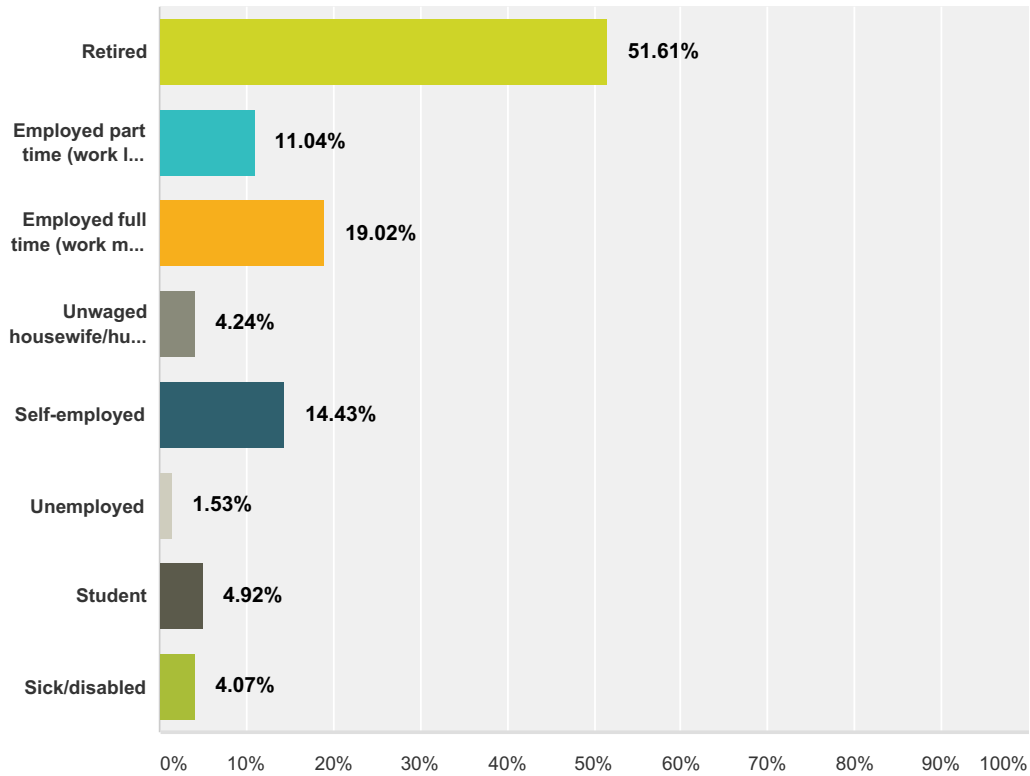
